THE ELEGANT VINES HAVE THRIVED IN THE COPIOUS SUN OF ACROSS THE LANGUEDOC-ROUSSILLON REGION, INCLUDING THE INIMITABLE CLAPE REGION, FARTHER TO THE SOUTH, WHERE THE GRAPES PROSPER IN A MARINE CLIMATE.

FROM OUT OF THIS EXTRAORDINARILY DAUNTING TERROIR YOU WILL FIND VINES OF UP TO 150 YEARS OLD THAT HAVE CONTINUED THROUGH THE YEARS, AS NURTURED BY DEDICATE LOYAL VINTNERS. THEY THRIVE AND LIVE ON, PRODUCING THE NOBLE GRAPES ARE MERLOT, CABERNET SAUVIGNON, SAUVIGNON BLANC, CHARDONNAY, MOUVEDRE, GRENACHE, SYRAH AND VIOGNIER.
